VALE INCO NEW CALEDONIA, partner in the 'dictionary at home for my primary school education' programme

On Friday 4 December 2009, the organisation Vocabulivre, represented by its president Clédia Barket-Verlaguet, received a gift from Vale Inco New Caledonia of a sum of 100,000 CFP to finance the 'dictionary at home for my primary school education' and 'learning through pictures and words' programme.

On the same day, works were distributed through schools on Ile Ouen and Saint-Louis.

Each year, some 900 pupils from Mont-Dore and 80 from Yaté receive their dictionary or personal picture book; a specific method of providing assistance within families.

Since 2007, Vale Inco New Caledonia has supported these activities for children in both stages of their primary school education at schools in Yaté and Mont Dore.

In this way Vale Inco New Caledonia intends to make an active contribution to the educational success of young people in Grand Sud.

Through this educational sponsorship, Vale Inco New Caledonia provides financial and logistical support to teaching projects in primary and secondary educational establishments in Grand Sud.
